Warnings

- In the use of the device, you must be in strict compliance with the electrical safety regulations of the nation and region.
- Input voltage should meet both the SELV (Safety Extra Low Voltage) and the Limited Power Source with 12 VDC according to the IEC60950-1 standard. Refer to technical specifications for detailed information.
- Do not connect multiple devices to one power adapter to avoid over-heating or a fire hazard caused by overload.

- To avoid heat accumulation, good ventilation is required for the operating environment.
- · Keep the camera away from liquid while in use for nonwater-proof device.

• While in delivery, the camera shall be packed in its original packing, or packing of the same texture.




Figure 1. 2 Type II Camera Overview

Chapter 2 Installation

2.1 Installation Preparation

Before you start:

- Make sure that the device in the package is in good condition and all the assembly parts are included.
- Make sure that all the related equipment is power-off during the installation.
- Check the specification of the products for the installation environment.
- Check whether the power supply is matched with your power output to avoid damage.
- Make sure the wall is strong enough to withstand three times the weight of the camera and the bracket.
- If the wall is cement, insert expansion bolts before you install the camera. If the wall is wooden, use self-tapping screws to secure the camera.
- If the product does not function properly, contact your dealer or the nearest service center. Do NOT

disassemble the camera for repair or maintenance by yourself.

Note:

Since type I camera and type II camera share the same installation method, we take type I camera as the example to describe the installation.

2.2 Wall Mounting

Before you start:

The package contains the wall mounting bracket.

Steps:

- 1. Attach the bracket to the wall.
- Mark the screw holes on the wall according to the holes on the bracket.
- 3. Drill the screw holes.
- Attach the bracket to the wall and secure the camera with supplied screws.




Figure 2. 1 Secure the camera to the wall

Note:

- In the supplied screw package, both self-tapping screws and expansion bolts are contained.
- If the wall is cement, expansion bolts are required to fix the camera. If the wall is wooden, self-tapping screws are required.
- Align the camera to the pedestal, and secure the camera on the pedestal with supplied screws.




Figure 2. 2 Secure the Camera on the Bracket

- Route the cables and connect the corresponding power cord and video cable.
- Power on the camera to check whether the image on the monitor is gotten from the optimum angle. If not, adjust the camera according to the figure below to get an optimum angle.
 - 1). Loosen the horizontal adjusting screw to adjust the pan position (0° to 360°).
 - 2). Tighten the horizontal adjusting screw.
 - 3). Loosen the vertical adjusting screw to adjust the tilt position (0° to 90°)
 - 4). Tighten the vertical adjusting screw.




Figure 2. 3 Angle Adjustment

2.3 Pendant Mounting

Before you start:

You need to purchase a pendant bracket first.

Steps:

- 1. Attach the bracket to the ceiling.
- Mark the screw holes on the ceiling according to the holes on the bracket.
- Drill the screw holes.
- 4. Attach the bracket to the ceiling and secure the camera with supplied screws.




Figure 2. 4 Fix the Bracket on the Ceiling

Note:

- In the supplied screw package, both self-tapping screws and expansion bolts are contained.
- If the wall is cement, expansion bolts are required to fix the camera. If the wall is wooden, self-tapping screws are required.
- 5. Remove the screw on the top of the camera to expose the screw hole.




Figure 2. 5 Remove the Screw

Align the screw hole on the top of the camera with the pendant mounting bracket and rotate the camera to get it fixed.




Figure 2. 6 Fix the Camera to the Bracket

- 7. Route the cables and connect the corresponding power cord and video cable.
- Power on the camera to check whether the image on the monitor is gotten from the optimum angle. If not, adjust the camera according to the figure below to get an optimum angle.
 - Loosen the adjusting knob to adjust the pan position (0° to 360°) and tilt position (0° to 90°)
 - 2). Tighten the adjusting knob.




Figure 2. 7 Angle Adjustment
